Modeling job offer through the Internet

A woman applied for a modeling job through an Internet ad. Actually, it was a false ad intended to get her to perform in the porn videos. She was coerced to sign a contract and appear in porn videos. The videos she appeared in were put up for sale.

"Lucrative" job offer in Japan

Foreign women were lured into "high income jobs" in Japan. Upon arrival, they were taken to hostess bars and forced to work as prostitutes. Their earnings were taken away by the exploiter.

Labor exploitation by threats

A male victim, who was a minor and live-in worker, was underpaid for such reasons as "making mistakes at work" and "not being punctual." He expressed his intention to quit the job, but he was physically harmed, threatened, and forced to continue working.

- Human trafficking consists of acts such as the transfer, harbouring or receipt of persons, using means such as force, threat, abduction or fraud, for the purpose of exploitation, such as prostitution and forced labor. It causes severe psychological and physical damage to victims.
- Forced prostitution is a grave violation of human dignity and human rights and must never be tolerated.
- Human trafficking and child prostitution, whether committed in Japan or abroad, are serious crimes and subject to punishment.

You can help the victims of human trafficking by reporting to the nearest Police Station or Immigration Office. Your information could lead to their rescue.

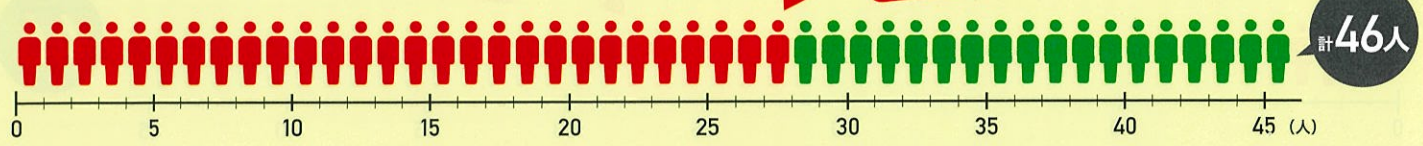

ネットでモデル募集



モデル募集を装ったサイトを作成し、応募者にアダルトビデオの撮影に関する契約書への署名を強要して、撮影に応じさせ、その動画を販売。

日本での儲け話



「日本で働けば稼げるよ。」などの甘い言葉で、外国人女性らを来日させ、勤め先としてスナック店をあっせん。売春を強制し、その代金を搾取。

脅して労働搾取



少年を住み込みで働かせ、遅刻や失敗を理由に賃金を搾取。「辞めたい」と訴えた少年を暴行・脅迫し、強制的に労働させた。

- 人身取引とは、売春や強制労働をさせるなどの搾取の目的で、暴力、脅迫、誘拐、詐欺などの手段を用いて、人を移動したり、隠したり、受け取ったりする行為であり、被害者に対して深刻な精神的・肉体的苦痛をもたらします。
- 買春は人間の尊厳を傷つけ、人権を軽視する行為であり、決して許されません。
- 人身取引と児童買春は、重大な犯罪であり、国の内外を問わず処罰の対象です。

被害者らしい人を見かけたり、助けを求められたら、最寄りの警察署や入国管理局に連絡してください。
