# Joint product development for commercialization of traditional **SWEETS** in Vietnam and Japan

- -Have you tried Japanese sweets before? If not, do you want to try them?
- -What kind of sweets do you eat on a daily basis?
- -Japan has very unique and localized Halloween and Valentine's Day tradition. Is there locally established tradition in Vietnam related to sweets?
- -What kind of traditional sweets does Vietnam have?
